Nisha and Anisha Gurung are sisters, their parents got inter-caste marriage. So their family did not accept them. Their parents stayed outside for few years and gave birth to two daughter (Nisha and Anisha). Sakshyam's father left them, since when she was one year old child. Her mother came to Pokhara to find a job, but due to a small child herself, people do not allow her to work. One of our members saw the mother searching a job and could not find, he brought them to RCH for finding help and support.

Samir BK, 13 years old has critical situation, His father's death due to poisoning, and his mother has no job, she is very old and cannot work due to her physical unfitness. Due to lack of regular income Samik BK cannot go to school for education.
